Infineon is a leading innovator in the international semiconductor industry. Headquartered in Munich, Germany, it ranks sixth among the top 10 semiconductor companies in 2002. The company designs, develops, manufactures and markets broad range of semiconductors, bio-micro technology and complete system solutions targeted at selected industries.

Bovis Lend Lease, in partnership with local developer, Ascendas Land, was awarded the build and lease of the new Infineon Asia Pacific Headquarters in Singapore following a four month bid process.

Bovis Lend Lease took over the

concept design from Tec Architect and was appointed as the management contractor the design and construction of the 300,000sq ft development located at the junction between Jalan Kolam Ayer and Kallang Way, situated beside the Pan Island Expressway.

The structure comprises two elliptical shaped buildings of 10-storeys high interconnected by link bridges at level 3 and 4. These 2 buildings are wrapped with Poly-tetra-fluoroethylene (PTFE) membrane façade system that gives the development a touch of elegance and sophistication. The membrane is a self-cleaning materials that requires minimum maintenance. Valued at S\$40million, Bovis Lend Lease delivered the project over a period of 16 months.

The completed new regional headquarters houses Infineon's corporate, marketing, logistics, as well as research and development functions all under one roof.
