Everything is built to engage and challenge a youngster's mind, hi tech solutions are prominent but not obvious throughout the park.

Behind more than 40 attractions, (rides, shows and displays), is an extremely complicated network of computerised electrical and mechanical features. Structures such as the mountain section of jungle within the Jungle X-pedition ride appear very realistic. Visitors only see the carved rockwork behind which is an intricate arrangement of steel frames supporting the ride itself and also the mountain.

It is anticipated that over 1.3 million people will visit the park in the first year alone. For this reason all elements of the park are designed with long-term maintenance and cost efficiencies in mind, which will mean any inconvenience is kept strictly to a minimum.

With the original program schedule being reduced by almost a full year, collaboration was the key ingredient to the success of the project – from the building of a large staff administration block, a café and retail stores, right down to the miniature roads for the Motor School where 7 year old children can take their first driving test. Every member of the team pulled together to ensure the park was ready for opening day.
