- Acquired by Australian Prime Property Fund Retail/MLC Life/GPT in 1992 with development rights
- Redevelopment by Lend Lease between 1992 – 1994
- Major expansion 2002 – 2003
- Late 2009 expansion to incorporate K-Mart and additional specialty shops
